<p>My Communication</p>	<p>Storybooks: Dinosaur Roar by Henrietta Stickland; Dinosaurs in Love by Fenn Rosenthal Non-fiction books about dinosaurs, reptiles, mini-beasts. PECs, communication charts, intensive interaction, attention autism (bucket time), curiosity box.</p>
<p>My Problem Solving</p>	<p>Mathematics: exploring size (big/not big); exploring capacity (full/not full)); counting songs and rhymes; 1:1 correspondence. Science: looking for fossils; meat-eating and plant-eating animals.</p>
<p>My Body</p>	<p>PE: sensory circuits; athletics and field games. Core skills: balance and coordination; bilateral motor coordination; spatial awareness Fine motor skills; finger family songs; dough disco; developing finger strength and agility. Our PE days are Monday and Wednesday.</p>
<p>My Wellbeing</p>	<p>PSHE, Self-Regulation, Relationships: taking care of our bodies (skin, teeth, hair); parts of the body and face; public/private (places and body parts); identifying pain/hurt in a particular part of the body; sun safety; transitions and getting on with new people; celebrating achievements</p>
<p>My World</p>	<p>Dinosaur fossils, footprints; packing a case for holiday; visiting the beach.</p>
<p>My Creativity</p>	<p>Music: dinosaur stomps, marching music Food technology: vegetarian salad, meat-eater snack (hot dogs), ice cream/lollies Art and Design: 2D dinosaur models, footprints, salt dough fossils, Father's Day crafts.</p>
