Our Focus this Term is: Long, Long Ago: Ruthless Romans

Our Learning in Term 6

My Communication	<p>We will be looking at a different story every week as well as having several sensory stories that run for several weeks. Every day our foxes will have one of these stories read to them during Storytime. Some of our stories will focus on the Romans as this is our termly topic, others will look at skeletons as this is our science topic.</p> <p>We will be supporting our foxes to communicate using symbols, words and Makaton.</p> <p>Some of our foxes will be engaged in regular attention autism sessions in order to support their focus and communication skills. Other foxes will have regular phonics lessons, learning the stage 1 sounds of the RWI scheme and starting to blend.</p>
My Problem Solving	<p>We will be developing our maths skills through number songs and counting activities every day. We will also be looking at money (coins) and time (daily routines). Every day we will learn about the days of the week. We will be looking at skeletons in some of our science based sessions. We will also be doing sensory science exploration and experiments.</p>
My Body	<p>In PE we will be practicing basic athletics for our sports day. We will also be developing our gross motor skills with a different weekly focus e.g. crawling, climbing, jumping etc. We will engage with sensory circuit sessions.</p> <p>We will work on our fine motor skills through regular mark making activities – using pens, but also using sensory media such as shaving foam, flour etc. We will also use playdough, tweezers, threading activities etc. to develop our fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination.</p>
My Wellbeing	<p>We will have a calm relaxation session every day after lunch to prepare us for the rest of the afternoon's learning. We will be naming our feelings and using a feelings chart to communicate how we feel every day. We will be practicing breathing exercises to help us calm and regulate when we are upset.</p>
My World	<p>We will be learning about the Romans. We will also be learning a little about volcanoes (these topics link together through our sensory story 'Escape from Pompeii').</p>

<p>My Creativity</p>	<p>We will be practicing different painting techniques such as using a straw to blow paint patterns. We will be working together as a whole class to build a volcano model. We will also be making mosaics, linked to our Romans topic.</p> <p>We will have regular 'musical conversations' sessions in which we sing, copy actions and look at feelings through music. We will also have a singing assembly every week during which we learn to sing and sign along to various songs.</p>
